Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

Roll Call: John Fuschino, Chris Higgins, Bill Noyce, Darla Youngblood, Dave Youngblood, Kelly Berndt, Sam Coppen, Jerry William, Brandon Bowen, Mark Findley, John Meyers.

Meeting called to order at 6:32 by Chris Higgins.

Reading of April 2009 Meeting Minutes: Motion to accept minutes by John Meyer, motion seconded by Bill Noyce. Motion approved.

**Treasurers Report:** given by John Fuschino. Motion to accept the report by Jerry William and seconded by Kelly Berndt. Motion approved.

**State Shoot Report:** Kelly Berndt reported that things were going good. He asked for some feedback about how many trophies to purchase. The major consensus was to have trophies out to third place in all classes.

**New Business:** Darla Youngblood made a comment that CSCA charges 5 cents per target and the NSCA only charges 3 cents. The CSCA officially charges 3 cents per target and 2 cents for maintenance fees. An amendment to the bylaws was passed and the change in the bylaws is in process.

Chris Higgins asked how we increase membership. His thoughts were to have the newsletter or an informative letter about the CSCA and sporting clay shooting posted at the ranges at corporate shoots. Chris will print up a letter and get it out to the range owners so that they can post them at their clubs.

Mark Findley suggested having a master shooter or instructor at one station at the corporate shoots to help the shooters and promote the sport and CSCA.

Kelly Berndt suggested a bulletin board or signs with pamphlet holders on the coarse so shooters can see them and take a copy.

**Old Business:** Kelly made a motion to put in the bylaws that the date of the Colorado State Shoot is to be on the first weekend of October. If the host club wants to change the date it must be voted on, by the members, by mail ballot. If this is the only issue to be voted on by the membership, the host club will pay for the cost of the ballot. Bill Noyce seconded the motion. Motion approved.

- Chris Higgins says the State Shoot Bid Form is too long and he is revising it.
- Chris Higgins will send out ballots to all the clubs.
- All applications must be returned by July 31 2009,
- If needed a mail ballot will be mailed to members by August 7 2009
- All ballots must be returned by August 17 2009
- Announcement of the 2010 Colorado State Shoot will be August 22 2009
- The next meeting will be at the state shoot August 22 2009 at 6:30 pm (dinner)
- Announce at the next meeting that we want 5 people to be on the State Shoot

- Committee to assist the host club in any way that is needed.
- Kathy Higgins is running the website and is trying to develop it better.
  - Chris suggested that there be a classified add section for members to post firearm related adds. Chris will look into the legalities of this.
  - Colorado has two open NSCA Delegate positions and applications must be submitted to the NSCA by July 21 2009.
  - Pikes Peak Gun Club wants to join the CSCA and John Meyers Jr. will get them an application.
  - Bill Noyce wants to get the 2010 Shoot Schedule made up at the October 2009 meeting. **It is mandatory that all range owners attend the meetings.**
  - Darla Youngblood discussed the ballot issues to be voted on by our delegates. Darla and Ron Fincher want to vote no on both issues and that was the consensus of the attendees of this meeting.
