## Motion 1:

A motion was made to approve Jan 19, 2012 Meeting Minutes. There was a motion to amend Motion number 3 related to minimum trophies presented during the Colorado State Shoot. The motion added Trophies for in-state HOA and R/U as well as All-Around trophy, awarded based on combined scores of: Main, FITASC, small gauge and pump. The vote passed unanimously.

- Balance \$6,112.50 (compared to last year at the same time of \$5,602.95)
- Pending deposits of \$6,645.00 will bring the balance to \$12,757.50

## Old Business

### 6 2 6 Challenge Analysis

- Positive feedback received
- A financial summary was provided to the board for informational purposes
- An article written by Matt Lane was presented to the board for consideration to include in the next newsletter
- Event statistics
  - 135 shooters completed all 6 fields
  - 180 shooters competed in some or all of the event
  - 13 states (including Hawaii) and Canada were represented
  - Over \$6,900 was paid out in class and options
  - 340 punches were awarded
- Emphasis for next year:

- Evaluate start times to accommodate drive time (i.e. 20 minutes travel from Quail Run to Boy Scout Ranch would facilitate an earlier start allowing additional travel time to River's Edge)
- Provide better maps, especially for out-of-state competitors
- More advertising prior to the event
- Discussion about criteria for Big Blast designation and confusion about this year's designation – Jon Kruger will follow up with NSCA headquarters for clarification and designation for the 2013 event
- Colorado's toughest 626 in 2013 will be held May 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>.

## **2012 State Championship Update**

- Brandon Bowen from River's Edge provided the following status for the upcoming State Shoot:
  - Working with Casey Chase to provide final information to open online registration. Expected date is May 25<sup>th</sup> to complete
  - Per Brandon and Jon Kruger enough machines have been arranged to allow the small gauge courses to remain set-up and allow the full 4 days for course completion
  - No progress has been made to date relative a master generator that would be accessible to all RV's.
    - Joe Phillips and Roxy Haines agreed to follow up with possible solutions
  - Setting up a waste removal company for RV's on site. There will be a sign-up for time and payment at the club house
  - Still coordinating the FITASC schedule – likely to be held on Saturday and Sunday only
  - ProMatic will be providing machines and on-site mechanics again this year
  - Advertising:
    - NSCA will provide mailing labels for regional areas at no charge – Brandon to follow-up
    - Post cards can be purchased/printed for ~\$0.09 each and mailed at bulk rate of ~\$0.19 each\

## **New Business**

- Roxy Haines put forward a request to move the CSCA checking account from Wells Fargo to 1<sup>st</sup> Bank. A motion was presented and passed unanimously.
