New Business

Motion 1:

A motion was made and passed to approve May 10, 2012 Meeting Minutes.

Treasurer's Report

State Shoot Update

- ◆ Rivers Edge reports that things are going well in preparation for the event.
- ◆ Still need sponsors
- ◆ Casey has been hired for scheduling, tracking scores and payouts.
- ◆ Option for electrical service to RV's is being evaluated. Roxy Haines will be sending information to Rivers Edge.

Big Blast Designation for 626 and Kruger Cup.

New Business

- ◆ John Meyers started discussion on ways to bring in more new young shooters which included.
 1. Reduce entry fees for standard shoots
 2. Reduce entry fee for state shoot above and beyond main event (3 events with max discount).
 3. Age limit put on young shooters of 18th birthday.
 4. Post on club website and e-mail juniors.
 5. Reduced rates for general shoot entry to be discussed by Club owners.

Motion

Bill Noyce put forth motion for CSCA to pay at state shoot ½ of entry fee of 3 events up to maximum of \$150.00 total for junior and younger shooters. John Meyers second motion however the motion failed.

Motion

Second motion put forth CSCA will pay for Juniors and younger ½ of main event and up to ½ of any other event. This motion passed. This was to be posted on website and e-mail.

- ◆ Conduct of shooters during tournaments. The conduct of shooters and procedures for protests were discussed. This was brought due to an incident occurring during the Kruger Cup along with prior issues concerning sportsman like conduct. It was determined that an article on code of conduct governed by the NSCA would be in the next Newsletter.
- ◆ Need articles for Newsletter. Sections on shooting or gun care tips written by professionals could benefit our membership.
- ◆ Roxy Haines requested that another meeting be held prior to the State Shoot.
