Treasurer's Report

- Balance in CSCA is \$16,392.70

 - Youth shooters do not understand the subsidy offered at state
 - Do not have any subsidy in place at this moment, until we vote for one
 - Look at options as to where we can put money to youth other than state
 - Have a family shoot that is like a buddy shoot
 - Have a youth option (similar to a class option)
 - Youth would choose to pay an extra \$10.00, 5 of which would go back to class and 5 would go to the scholarship fund.
 - Put box on registration for registered shooters for all clubs
 - If checked person donates to the scholarship fund
