 - Need clubs to help
 - Had so many out of state issue and having to refund money
 - Lots of work on a volunteer basis
 - Burden on clubs was felt by shooters
 - Communication to new shooter needs to be better
 - The board failed too by not helping more
 - If clubs were engaged more, they would know more
 - Go back to set rotation?
 - Shoot Friday and Saturday?
 - Both shoots are done as of now and will not be back unless big changes are made.
