Treasurer's Report

- \$52,000.00 total in CSCA

 - CSCA is \$34,188.40
- Up \$7,000.00 from last year

- Need a full audit of books
- VP to do this yearly

2019 State Shoot

- CH Shoot results
 - Set up the main backwards
 - Paid out of state not in state
 - All fixed with the shooters
 - All fixed with Longmeadow
 - Out of State was paid more than expected
- Board Payout is complicated
- Been correct last 2 years
- Could change pay outs but have them set up to protect in state shooters
 - Who bring in the funds during the year
- Change that payouts are public?
- Would be faster to pay with printed checks
 - Need accurate shooter info
- New rule
 - Shooters have to be paid within 15 days
 - “shooter” is clarified in new rule
- In future expectations of scorekeepers needs to be clear and verbalized
- Out of state shooters
 - Confusion on shoot offs – knowing when and where
 - Had trouble getting to where they needed to be in time
 - Scores posted at 4pm??
 - Need to investigate?
 - NO formal complaint filed so NO investigation
- Survey results from shooters at state
 - Heath reviewed
 - Suggestions
 - Water truck
 - Better food options

- Trophy improvement
 - Put sub gauge name on trophy
 - can re-use is not labeled
 - Belt buckles are popular
- Score keepers need more training
 - Will continuously be an issue
- Changed the targets too much??
