- BOD Member Representative Updates
 - [MOTION] Dean Blanchard – Jason Leleck moves for Dean to fill vacant member rep position, Jeff Marlatt 2nd, no opposed.
- 2021 Shoot Schedule
 - Jason send an email to complete scheduling
- 2021 State Shoot Bids
 - Jeff Marlatt/Bill Noyce
 - Bid from Pikes Peak – tentative to Pikes Peak sept 15-19th – Jeff & Bill to confirm
 - Bid from Longmeadow
 - Target Setter – Jeff & Bill solicit bids for target setters again
 - Youth Fund – will play by ear right now, but still on track for same as previous year
- CAMEO Range – Grand Junction
 - Jeff – new range outside of Palisade on Western Slope
 - 2000 Acre Facility
 - Hosting world championship pistol shooting, 2000 yd range, 1000 yd range, 15 station sporting, 8 station super sporting “executive” range on the butte, also building a 5-

- stand, already have the machines. They have 63 machines on site. Course set by Neil Chadwick, \$40 per round of 100. It's like shooting in the Grand Canyon.
- Interested in having registered shoots there, but must be setup as a user group, must have an RSO setup. \$50-100/yr to get setup. Since it's owned by the state, we need to supply our own liability insurance (likely additional \$500-600/yr).
 - Dean – who would be doing the target setting? Jeff – we would likely need to get a target setter, Neil may come for the first shoot. Dean - Could get shooters to set targets? Allowed to move the machines
 - Bruce Jones – would the other clubs be ok with it? Do the local clubs have an issue with it?
 - John McCord – what is the timeline on user group/insurance. Jeff ~1 month for state user group approval, 2 weeks for liability insurance
 - Survey for interest in shooting in Cameo. Shoot possible in 2021?
 - Any clubs interested in being the host of that event?
 - Include in 2021 scheduling
 - 90 person charity shoot around Aug 1
 - New Registration Platform – ScoreChaser
 - Free to start
 - Pre-registration, online registration
 - 3.5% to take payment and transfer schedule
 - Next level \$200 yr, additional reporting
 - Highest level \$800 yr, course menus, adhoc email and sms, promoted shoot listings
 - Clubs have interest and will setup some time demo's from Casey
 - Heath – try to do a test run/preview with Casey in the next few months. Longmeadow is open to it. Great Guns & Quail Run, Colorado Clays, Republic would be interested.
 - Jason – send out an email.
